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MEASUREMENT

Length: 15.2 cm/6 Inch
High: 12.5 cm/5 Inch

TOOLS AND MATERIAL

Ricorumi dk
Shade 044 (grass green) 25 g
Shade 045 (pastel green) 50 g
Shade 008 (rose) 25 g
Shade 002 (cream) 25 g
Shade 028 (red) 25 g
Shade 060 (black) 25 g
2.25 mm crochet hook
White embroidery thread.

TENSION

26 sts and 28 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm

BODY PART 1

Rnd 1: In pastel green yarn working into magic ring, 8 dc. 8 sts.
Work in a spiral in continuous rnds.
Rnd 2: [2 dc in next st] 8 times. 16 sts.
Rnd 3: [1 dc, 2 dc in next st] 8 times. 24 sts.
Rnd 4: [3 dc, 2 dc in next st] 6 times. 30 sts.
Rnd 5: 2 dc, 2 dc in next st, [4 dc, 2 dc in next st] 5 times, 2 dc. 36 sts.
Rnd 6: [5 dc, 2 dc in next st] 6 times. 42 sts.
Rnd 7: 3 dc, 2 dc in next st, [6 dc, 2 dc in next st] 5 times, 3 dc. 48 sts.
Rnd 8: [7 dc, 2 dc in next st] 6 times. 54 sts.
Rnd 9: 4 dc, 2 dc in next st, [8 dc, 2 dc in next st] 5 times, 4 dc. 60 sts.
Rnd 10: [9 dc, 2 dc in next st] 6 times. 66 sts.
Break the yarn and fasten off the yarn tail.

BODY PART 2

Rnd 1: In grass green yarn working into magic ring, 8 dc. 8 sts.
Work in a spiral in continuous rnds.
Rnd 2: [2 dc in next st] 8 times. 16 sts.
Rnd 3: [1 dc, 2 dc in next st] 8 times. 24 sts.
Rnd 4: [3 dc, 2 dc in next st] 6 times. 30 sts.
Rnd 5: 2 dc, 2 dc in next st, [4 dc, 2 dc in next st] 5 times, 2 dc. 36 sts.
Rnd 6: [5 dc, 2 dc in next st] 6 times. 42 sts.
Rnd 7: 3 dc, 2 dc in next st, [6 dc, 2 dc in next st] 5 times, 3 dc. 48 sts.
Rnd 8: [7 dc, 2 dc in next st] 6 times. 54 sts.
Rnd 9: 4 dc, 2 dc in next st, [8 dc, 2 dc in next st] 5 times, 4 dc. 60 sts.
Rnd 10: 60 dc. 60 sts.
Rnd 11: [9 dc, 2 dc in next st] 6 times. 66 sts.
Rnd 12-18: 66 dc. 66 sts. (7 rnds)
Rnd 19: Closing the body. Place body part 1 with the wrong side facing the opening of body part 2, 66 dc through both part 1 and part 2.
Stuff firmly before closing the hole.
Break the yarn and fasten off the yarn tail.

CHEEK (MAKE 2)

Rnd 1: With rose yarn working into magic ring, 6 dc. End with sl st into 1st st to join. 6 sts.
Break the yarn and leave a long tail for sewing later.

HEAD

Rnd 1: With pastel green yarn working into magic ring, 6 dc. 6 sts.
Work in a spiral in continuous rnds.
Rnd 2: [2 dc in next st] 6 times. 12 sts.
Rnd 3: [1 dc, 2 dc in next st] 6 times. 18 sts.
Rnd 4: 1 dc, 2 dc in next st, [2 dc, 2 dc in next st] 5 times, 1 dc. 24 sts.
Rnd 5: [3 dc, 2 dc in next st] 6 times. 30 sts.
Rnd 6: 2 dc, 2 dc in next st, [4 dc, 2 dc in next st] 5 times, 2 dc. 36 sts.
Rnd 7: [5 dc, 2 dc in next st] 6 times. 42 sts.
Rnds 8-13: 42 dc. 42 sts. (6 rnds)
Rnd 14: [5 dc, dc2tog] 6 times. 36 sts.
Rnd 15: 2 dc, dc2tog, [4 dc, dc2tog] 5 times, 2 dc. 30 sts.
Rnd 16: [3 dc, dc2tog] 6 times. 24 sts.
Rnd 17: 1 dc, dc2tog, [2 dc, dc2tog] 5 times, 1 dc. 18 sts.
Rnd 18-30: 18 dc. 18 sts. (13 rnds)
Rnd 31: Stuff the head firmly, do not stuff the neck.
Flatten the neck and dc through both sides to close.
Break the yarn and leave a long tail for sewing later.
Place the neck on the pastel green body part just under the grass green edge. Sew on, do not cut the yarn. Fold the head up over the grass green body part and sew a few stitches between head and body to make sure it stays up. Fasten off the yarn tail.

With black, embroider 2 black eyes over rounds 9-10, with approximately 9 stitches in between.
With white embroidery thread, embroider white lines and eye details.
In black, embroider a black line over the eye.
With pastel green yarn, embroider 2 vertical shaped nostrils approx 3 stitches from the eyes over rounds 11-12, with 3 stitches in between.
Sew on the cheeks next to the eyes over rounds 12-14.

LEG (MAKE 4)

Rnd 1: In pastel green yarn working into magic ring, 6 dc. 6 sts.
Work in a spiral in continuous rnds.
Rnd 2: [2 dc in the next st] 6 times. 12 sts.
Rnd 3: [1 dc, 2 dc in the next st] 6 times. 18 sts.
Rnd 4: 3 dc, [bo, 1 dc in the next st] 2 times, bo, 10 dc. 18 sts.
Rnd 5: 18 dc. 18 sts.
Rnd 6: 3 dc, [dc2tog] 3 times, 9 dc. 15 sts.
Rnds 7-10: 15 dc. 15 sts. (4 rnds)
Rnd 11: [3 dc, dc2tog in next st] 3 times. 12 sts.
Stuff the legs.
Break the yarn and leave a long tail for sewing later. Place 2 legs on each side of the head, and 2 legs in the back, 1 round from the grass green edge. Before you sew on the legs make sure the turtle can stand up.

BANDANA

Rnd 1: With red yarn working into magic ring, 6 dc. 6 sts.
Work in a spiral in continuous rnds.
Rnd 2: [2 dc in next st] 6 times. 12 sts.
Rnd 3: [1 dc, 2 dc in next st] 6 times. 18 sts.
Rnd 4: 1 dc, 2 dc in next st, [2 dc, 2 dc in next st] 5 times, 1 dc. 24 sts.
Rnd 5: [3 dc, 2 dc in next st] 6 times. 30 sts.
Rnd 6: 2 dc, 2 dc in next st, [4 dc, 2 dc in next st] 5 times, 2 dc. 36 sts.
Rnd 7: [5 dc, 2 dc in next st] 6 times. 42 sts.
Rnds 8-10: 42 dc. 42 sts. (3 rnds)
Rnd 11: [ch 6, start in your second ch from the hook, 1 dc, 1 htr in the next ch, 1 tr in the next ch, 1 htr in the next ch, 1 dc in the next ch] 2 times, 1 dc in the first ch, 1 dc in the next st, sl st in next st.
Break the yarn and leave a long tail for sewing later.
Sew on the bandana to the head.

TAIL

Rnd 1: With pastel green yarn working into magic ring, 4 dc. 4 sts.
Work in a spiral in continuous rnds.
Rnd 2: 2 dc in next st, 3 dc. 5 sts.
Rnd 3: 2 dc in next st, 4 dc. 6 sts.
Rnd 4: 2 dc in next st, 5 dc. 7 sts.
Rnd 5: 2 dc in next st, 6 dc. 8 sts.
Rnd 6: 2 dc in next st, 7 dc. 9 sts.
Rnd 7: 2 dc in next st, 8 dc. 10 sts.
Rnd 8: Stuff tail lightly. Flatten the tail and dc across through both sides to close the tail.
Break the yarn and leave a long tail for sewing.
Sew on the tail between the back legs just under the edge of the shell.

TREASURE MAP

Row 1: With cream yarn working in rows, ch 11.
Row 2-6: Starting in the second ch from your hook, 1 dc in the next 10 sts. ch 1, turn your work. 10 sts.
Rnd 7: 1 dc in each st around the map, 2 dc in each corner.
With red yarn, embroider a red cross on the map.
With black yarn, embroider running stitches on the map from the cross, in a snake shape down to the end corner.
With red yarn, embroider a red cross at the shell.
With black yarn, embroider running stitches around the shell to mark a path.
